The required classes are as follows:

1. Fine Shaded Flowers - 5 days
2. Dye Class with "Hands-On" work - 5 days
3. Teacher Training - 5 days

As well as the classes, there are specific hooking projects designed to demonstrate the skills learned in the various categories.
